## **12 February, 2021**

Yesterday, BAA and bargaining representatives met to begin negotiations for a new enterprise agreement to replace the Boeing Aerostructures Australia (Port Melbourne) Enterprise Agreement 2018. While BAA employees attended, union officials did not.

The meeting was friendly, and covered:

- Introductions of most participants (you can see a full list of bargaining representatives [here](#))
- Schedule of meetings – these will be fortnightly on Thursdays, with all

parties agreeing to provide their log of claims at the next meeting.

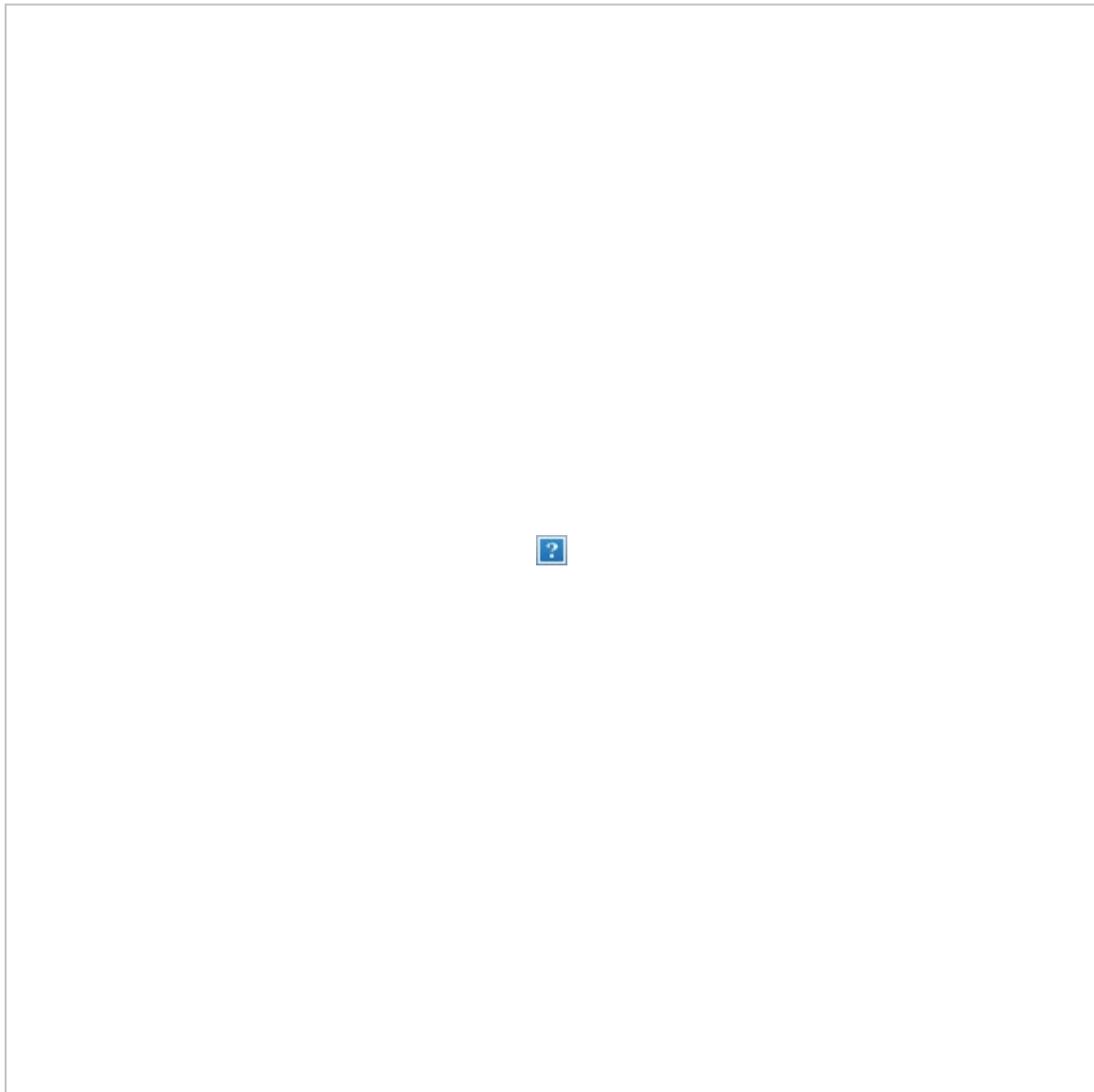
- BAA provided a list of clauses from the 2018 Agreement to be redrafted to meet the Fair Work Commission approval requirements. The Company also provided proposed wording for the first of these, for discussion at the next meeting.

All parties in attendance agreed to meet in two weeks' time on Thursday, 25 February to share their Log of Claims.

This was a good start to the negotiation process, and I look forward to keeping you updated on our progress in coming weeks.
